SNOOKER and POOL

MEMBERSHIP

1. Application for membership shall be made on the club's Application Form.
2. The club reserves the right to refuse membership.
3. Membership cards must be produced upon entry.
4. Failure to produce Membership Card will result in guest charges applying.
5. Membership cards are not transferable.
6. A member can only admit a maximum of 3 guests, who must sign in the Guest Book upon entry.
7. No more than 4 people are allowed at any one table
8. The member shall be held responsible and liable for the conduct of their guests.
9. A member shall not, at any time, introduce any guest who has been expelled from the club.
10. No applicant shall become a member until their application has been approved by the Management.
11. All membership fees are non-refundable.
12. Membership to be renewed annually.
13. The Club reserves the right to change fees & other charges as it sees fit
14. The Membership Card remains the property of the club.
15. Information data on individual members will only be used for the marketing of the club.
No member information will be shared with a third party

GUEST PLAYER

1. Each guest is required to sign in at the reception desk
2. Guests will be required to pay the nominal non-member entry fee at the reception desk
3. Non-member entry fees shall be paid at each visit
4. Those awaiting confirmation of their membership shall be asked to pay the non-member entry fee

CLUB RULES

1. Strictly NO Alcohol allowed on the premises.
2. Only food & drink purchased in the club is to be consumed on the premises.
3. Table lights will not be switched off until the balls are returned to reception.
4. Every member shall pay all expenses incurred by him before leaving the premises.
5. The member will be held responsible for any acts of vandalism, or damage, caused to the club premises or equipment i.e. breaking cues, tearing table cloth, damage to furniture etc. The member will be liable for any such damage, and the club will endeavour to recover the replacement cost from the member.
6. Acts of violence, threats and verbal abuse against staff or other members / guest(s) will result in your membership being terminated.
7. Any member found using or supplying illegal substances on the premises will have their membership revoked and their details will be passed onto the authorities.
8. The Club will not be held responsible for any items left or lost on the premises.
9. Consideration must be given to other players and noise levels must be kept to a minimum.

PENALTIES

- 1.1 Penalties will be issued by the supervisor to members who contravene any of the existing or future rules or guidelines of the club
- 1.2 Members may not be granted access to the club if the management decides they are in contravention of any of the club's rules
- 1.3 Penalties will be logged on to the members entry on the EPoS system
- 1.4 Members will be required to submit a letter of apology
- 1.5 Members have the right to appeal any penalty.
 - 1.5.1 The appeals panel will consist of the supervisor and 2 directors
 - 1.5.2 The appeals process requires written submissions from all the parties involved
 - 1.5.3 Video recordings will also be accessed if required
 - 1.5.4 Where the appeals panel sees fit they will request the attendance of the complainant.
 - 1.5.4.1 Non attendance of the complainant shall void the appeals process
 - 1.5.5 The decision of the appeals panel will be final
- 1.6 Minor offences will incur one penalty
 - 1.6.1 Minor offences include, but are not limited to
 - 1.6.1.1 Verbal abuse
 - 1.6.1.2 Inappropriate clothing
 - 1.6.1.3 Inappropriate jewellery
 - 1.6.1.4 Playing music, singing or whistling
 - 1.6.1.5 Littering the hall
 - 1.6.1.6 Chewing gum
 - 1.6.1.7 Irresponsible parking
- 1.7 Major offences shall disqualify the individual's membership
- 1.8 Disqualification of membership means the offending member shall have his membership suspended until such a time the management sees fit to reinstate his membership status
 - 1.8.1 Major offences include, but are not limited to
 - 1.8.1.1 Damage to equipment and property
 - 1.8.1.2 Physical abuse against others
 - 1.8.1.3 Smoking in non smoking areas
 - 1.8.1.4 Any other offences introduced by the management
